Revelation 7:9-10


Pray





Pray

for a larger missionary force to go into the abundant harvest. Ask God for 1% of our church members to respond.

Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.”

Matthew 9:37–38

Pray

that we would respond in obedience to God's call to make disciples, wherever we live or are called to go.

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the

name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

Matthew 28:19–20

Pray

that God would give us compassionate hearts for those living in darkness and that we would yearn for the light of Christ to come to them.

Pray

for our missionaries—and all of us—to boldly proclaim and visibly demonstrate the gospel.

To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel.
